2) Proceedings of the Syndicate meeting held on 8.10.2015.

Pursuant to the approval of the Statutes to establish the Centre for Information Science and Technology ('CIST' for short) (vide Ref. (1) above), it is hereby notified that the CIST is established as an independent Institute of University of Mysore, with immediate effect.

The Centre shall continue to function in its existing place at Senate Bhavan, Manasagangotri, Mysuru. The following vacant posts attached to the University Computer Centre vide Table 1, are now shifted to the CIST and they are converted into the posts shown in Table 2.





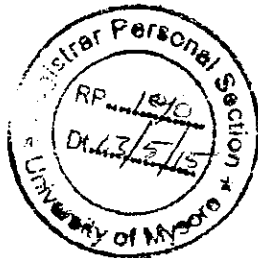

PREAMBLE:


1. The State Government and the Office of His Excellency the Chancellor were kind enough to approve the Statutes for "Establishing Centre for Computer Science and Information Technology by merger of University Computer Centre and Centre for Information Science and Technology (CIST), 2009" – vide letter No.ED 06 UMS 2010 dated 5.5.2012.


2. In the letter No.DV 3/74/CCIT/2012-13 dated 17.12.2012 addressed to the Principal Secretary to Government, Education Department (Universities), Bangalore, the University has proposed certain amendments to the above approved Statutes and sent the draft amendment Statutes for the assent of His Excellency the Chancellor. The amendments are yet to be approved.

3. The approved Statutes have not yet been implemented. Meantime, the University has re-examined the approved Statutes by constituting a Committee with the following Members:

- 1) Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor
- 2) The Director, CIST
- 3) The Head of the University Computer Centre
- 4) The Director, EMMRC
- 5) The Chairman, DOS in Computer Science

4. The Committee has examined all pros and cons of the merger of (1) University Computer Centre (hereinafter referred to as UCC) and (2) Centre for information science and technology (hereinafter referred to as CIST) and the benefits of such merger to the University. The UCC is a non-teaching Department of the University and its Programmers, at present, assisting the University in salary payments, cash book and accounts of the University etc., apart from providing training classes to interested public like house-wives,

employees etc. If the Programmers are upgraded as Assistant Professors as provided in the approved Statutes, it only helps the incumbents and not the University and in that case, the University would lose those Programmer posts. Besides, teaching work load and other assignments as prescribed by the UGC for teachers, cannot be provided to these Programmers. Therefore, the Committee is of view that UCC may continue as it is now, without merging with CIST since the proposed merger would not serve any purpose.


5. The CIST is a temporary establishment of the University meeting its expenses by its own sources. The CIST is providing Diploma and Certificate courses and helping the students in training them for job oriented courses. It is proposed by the University to start some technical courses in PG section in CIST. It is necessary to convert this establishment as a permanent one and treat it as one of the institutes of the University. Such conversion requires framing of Statutes.





8. THE CONVERSION OF CIST AS ONE OF THE PERMANENT ESTABLISHMENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY IS WITHOUT ANY FINANCIAL COMMITMENT ON THE PART OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT. THE EXPENDITURE WILL BE MET OUT OF ITS SOURCES OF CIST. HOWEVER, THE SAVINGS OF VACANT POSTS IN UCC WHICH ARE BEING SHIFTED TO CIST, WILL BE UTILISED FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF CIST.

9. The matter is placed before the Academic Council at its meeting held on 25-07-2013 and the proposal is approved. The Syndicate has also approved the proposal and the draft Statutes at its meeting held on 23-07-2013.


10. These draft Statutes would replace the approved Statutes mentioned at para 1 above and the amendments proposed as at para 2 above.


In these circumstances, the following Statutes are framed:

IN EXERCISE OF POWERS CONFERRED BY SEC. 29(2)(t) READ WITH SEC. 31(2)(viii) AND SEC. 40(1)(f) AND ALSO SEC. 41 OF KARNATAKA STATE UNIVERSITIES ACT, 2000, THE SYNDICATE MAKES THE FOLLOWING STATUTES.

I. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

(1) These Statutes shall be called, "The University of Mysore (establishment of the Centre for Information Science and Technology) Statutes, 2013;

(2) They shall come into force from the date they are assented to by the Chancellor.


II. DEFINITIONS:


- 1) "University" means the University of Mysore.
- 2) "Act" means the Karnataka State Universities Act, 2000.
- 3) "Centre" means the Centre for Information Science and Technology.
- 4) "Syndicate" means Syndicate of the University.
- 5) "Academic Council" means the Academic Council of the University.
- 6) The words which are not defined in the Statutes shall carry the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

III. ACTIVITIES:

The Centre shall impart education in the following courses:

- 1) Master of Science in Animation
- 2) Master of Science in Information Technology – proposed to commence shortly
- 3) PG Diploma in Software Development
- 4) - do – in Bio-informatics
- 5) – do – in Geo-Informatics
- 6) – do – E-Commerce
- 7) – do – Multimedia Technology
- 8) – do – Publication Design
- 9) Advanced Diploma in Information Technology
- 10) Diploma in Multimedia Production, and
- 11) 35 Certificate in various technical courses


V. ORDINANCES:

REPEAL:

The Statutes for "Establishing Centre for Computer Science and Information Technology by merger of University Computer Centre and Centre for Information Science and Technology (CIST), 2009" – approved by His Excellency the Chancellor and communicated in the letter of the State Government in No. ED 06 UMS 2010 dated 5.5.2012, stands repealed.

Further, the draft amendments to the approved Statutes and sent to the State Government in the letter No. DV 3/74/CCIT/2012-13 dated 17.12.2012 for the assent of the Chancellor, shall also be treated as WITHDRAWN.

Resolvable:

Draft Statutes have been framed for Establishing Centre for Computer Science and Information Technology by Merger of University Computer Centre & Centre for Science & Technology (CIST), 2009 & had been forwarded the Government. Vide Letter No. DV.2/298/2009-10, dated 10-07-2012. The said statute have been assented to by the Chancellor vide letter No.ED.06 UMS 2010, dated 05-05-2012 and the said statute have been notified vide notification No.DV.2/298/2009-10, dated: 07-05-2012 cited on Ref(1).

Certain amendments had been proposed to the said statute and the same has been forwarded to the Government for approval vide letter No.DV 3/74/CCIT/2012-13 dt.17-12-2012. Now on the basis of the statutes assented by the Chancellor the following order is issued.

ORDER NO.DV.3/74/CCIT/2012-13, DATED 09-01-2013

Pursuant to the approval of the Syndicate held on 18-10-2012 and order of the Vice Chancellor and as per statutes notified vide Reference No.DV.2/298/2009-10, dated: 07-05-2012 from the date of commencement of this statute the University Computer Centre and the Centre for Information Science and Technology stand merged to constitute a new body called Centre for "Computer Science and Information Technology (CIST)", as a consequence of which:

- a. All the equipments, posts, assets and funds acquired/created for both the erstwhile UCC and CIST shall be treated as the equipments, Posts, assets and funds of the Centre for Computer Science and Information Technology.
- b. The Courses and activities run and the functions/ duties performed by erstwhile UCC and CIST shall be undertaken by CCSIT.
- c. The course on M.Sc (IT) may also be offered by CCSIT.


Preamble

There exists great demand for training students and knowledge aspirants in computer science and information technology. The U.G.C. had extended its assistance to UOM for establishing a 'Computer Centre' so as to cater to the requirements of different departments of the University by assisting academic works, research activities and automation and computing. This Computer Centre was established during 1980 with the financial assistance provided by the UGC. Eighteen technical and ministerial posts were instituted by the University under a statute approved by His Excellency the Chancellor on 01-10-1980 (vide Annexure-1). His Excellency also gave approval for another two positions one post of Sweeper in 1984 and one post of Electric Mechanic-cum-air condition plant operator in 1986. (Annexure-II)

Thus there are, in all, 20 sanctioned posts approved by the Chancellor in the Computer Section in the 1990. The UGC in its letter (DO No.F-1-1/87 (TII) dated 9.10.1980. issued guidelines prescribing staffing pattern with revised scales of pay and qualifications required (Annexure-III). As per the said guidelines, the Computer Centre of level C could have 18 posts carrying UGC scale of pay and 05 supporting staff carrying State Scales of pay.

Considering the requirements of training the youth, house wives and others in I.T. application, University of Mysore established another Centre, called 'Centre for Information Science & Technology (CIST)' in 2001, as a totally self-supporting unit and autonomous body by submitting a draft Statute (Statutes for Establishment of Mysore University Centre for Information Science and Technology, 2000) to the government to obtain assent of His Excellency the Chancellor for his approval.

The Draft Statutes contemplated appointment of Guest/Visiting faculty and Honorary Professors and faculty on contract basis with the approval of the Vice Chancellor. It also contemplated appointment of supportive staff: 1 Assistant Director, 1 Office Manager/PA to Director, 2 Technical Assistants, 1 Administrative Assistant and 2 Attenders. Director was to be appointed by deputation from among one of the serving Professors in the PG Departments.


In anticipation of Chancellor's approval, with certain basic infrastructures and temporary appointment of employees, CIST was started functioning in 2001 and run successfully offering training to thousands of students, housewives, unemployed persons and persons who have been employed in different sectors. It also offered short term training to acquire computer skills to employees of various organizations.

On 11th January 2008, under the Chairmanship of the Principal Secretary to the Government of Karnataka Higher Education, a meeting was held and it was decided that CIST shall be merged with the University Computer centre and all affairs of CIST shall be brought under the direct control of the University. An order was also issued to give effect to the decision. But owing to some resistance from the students against loss of identity of CIST the status quo was continued. However, the examination work and financial supervision were assumed by the University.

Subsequently, the UGC 11th Plan Visiting Team who visited the University in 2009 made a clear recommendation for merger of University Computer Centre and CIST to constitute a single establishment to be named as "CENTRE FOR COMPUTER SCIENCE AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY" wherein all the existing posts of Computer Centre shall continue with necessary redesignations.

Since it is expedient to give effect to the guidelines given by the UGC and Karnataka Government decision dated 11-01-2008 and also to implement the recommendation of UGC Experts team, for optimum utilization of man-power and infrastructure resources already available and for expanding training programmes and also for designing new courses in tune with the market demands of IT world this Statute is framed.

Title and Commencement:

(ii) This Statute shall come into force from the date of assent of His Excellency the Chancellor.


2. Definition:

(i) Centre for Information Science and Technology (CIST) means the centre established in that name by the University of Mysore in the year 2001 on fully self-supportive basis under the draft Statutes for Establishment of Mysore University Centre for Information Science and Technology, 2000 to offer Diploma and PG Diploma courses in various aspects of computer handling and to run training programmes to include IT based skills among youth and others. And also to provide extension services.

(ii) University Computer Centre (UCC) means the Centre established by the University of Mysore in 1980 with the assistance by the UGC with posts created under Statutes approved by the Chancellor on 01-10-1980, 5-3-1984 and 24-12-1986 for helping academic and research activities, and providing training for the faculty and students in various departments and to carry on computing works of the University.

3. Merger and its effect

From the date of commencement of this Statute the University Computer Centre and the Centre for Information Science and Technology shall stand merged to constitute a new body called Centre for "Computer Science and Information Technology (CIST)", as a consequence of which:

- (a) All the equipments, posts, assets and funds acquired/created for both the erstwhile UCC and CIST shall be treated as the equipments, posts, assets and funds of the Centre for Computer Science and Information Technology.
- (b) the courses and activities run and functions/duties performed by erstwhile UCC and CIST shall be undertaken by CCSIT
- (c) the course on M Sc (IT) may also be offered by CCSIT

4. Protection of the interests of employees drawn from erstwhile UCC


The present incumbents of posts under UCC who are appointed by a duly constituted BOA shall continue against their respective re-designated posts as envisaged in these statutes subject to fulfillment of qualifications prescribed thereto. Provided however that in case they do not possess the requisite qualifications, they shall be entitled to the present pay scale or future pay scale admissible for them from time to time for their respective service and shall perform the duties presently assigned to them in addition to teaching assignment if any. They shall however be not entitled to promotions unless they acquire the qualification prescribed in these statutes.

5. Protection of the interests of employees drawn from erstwhile CIST

The persons serving as Lecturers, Assistant Librarian, Technician (Electrical), First Division Clerk, Second Division Clerk, Technician (H&N) and Sweeper under contract basis shall be continued in their service until the expiry of the period of contract. They shall be entitled to age relaxation in the context of filing applications for recruitment to various posts under the CCSIT when notified by the University.



Sub: Statute governing establishment of Centre for Information
Science and Technology (CIST) in Mysore University.

Ref: Your Letter No. DV1/16/CIST/99-2000 dated: 11-11-2000.

1) Previously assent was solicited to the Statute for establishment of Mysore University Center for Information Science and Technology (CIST) in the letter dated: 11-05-1999 of Mysore University. It involved creation of a post of Director in the UGC pay scale of Rs. 16400-22400. In view of ban on creation of post in terms of circular No: FE 3 SRP 98 dated: 14-02-1998 the assent was withhold and in Government Letter No. ED 31 UMS 99 dated: 21-07-99 the Mysore University was informed of the fact of withholding the assent. Later in its letter dated: 09-08-99 the Mysore University had clarified that the appointment of Director shall be only on contract basis for a period of three years and the entire financial operation shall be managed by the CIST with no liability on the University. Mysore University was informed in GL No. ED 31 UMS 99 dated: 30-08-99 that there was no scope for creation of any post; and could delete the post of Director and insert a provision to the effect that a Professor shall be an Ex-Officio Director on redeployment basis for the management of the CIST and there after it could retransmit the Statute. Responding to it the Vice Chancellor in his letter Dated: 06-09-99 had informed that Statutes if approved would be implemented by designating one of the professors as Director and there shall not be creation of any new post. Since the Statute to designate a Professor as Ex-Officio Director was not approved by the Syndicate and Senate and clause 6 of the Statute was to be substituted, it became imperative to return the Statute. Accordingly the Vice Chancellor was informed of it and the Statute was returned vide GL No. ED 31 UMS 99 dated: 04-11-99. In reply to it the

Vice Chancellor, Mysore University. In his letter dated: 01-12-99 had insisted that the post of Director was absolutely necessary and it should be filled either by deputation of a Professor on contract through open selection for 3 years in the first instance. It was on self financing basis and the entire expenditure on salary could be met out of the resources generated by the CIST. As such he had submitted the Statute for assent. Again it was examined in the light of requirement of a clearance of Syndicate and Senate to the modifications suggested therein. Accordingly a clarification was sought for from the Registrar, Mysore University in GL.No. ED 31 UMS 99 dated: 22-02-2000. While clarifying to the points in GL dated: 22-02-2000 the Mysore University had submitted another draft Statute duly incorporating the modifications suggested in the Syndicate meeting held on 22-03-99 and getting the clearance of Syndicate and Senate in their meetings held on 06-03-2000 and 31-03-2000. Emphasis was laid to the indication that the centre could function purely on self-financing basis without any financial commitment on the part of the Government. The Revised Statute was consisted to impose a condition that a Director shall be appointed by the Syndicate by designating an existing Professor on tenure basis who will also function as Director on his own pay and grade. The Statute was not assented but it was returned to resubmit after incorporating the above condition in the draft Statute. In furtherance of it in Government letter No. ED 31 UMS 99 dated: 17-07-2000 while returning the Statute it was clarified that even for appointment on contract for 3 years it is imperative that a sanctioned post of Director should exist. It was suggested to identify and designate a Professor on redeployment to be the Professor and Director of the Centre and submit after the approval of the Syndicate and Senate.

2) Clause 5 relates to consultation of a Governing Council for the guidance and monitoring of CIST in proper planning and integrated development of its activities under the Chairmanship of VC and the Director as Ex-Officio Member Secretary. It is responsible for academic, administrative, financial affairs and oversee the activities and give directions and focus on its functioning on a high level quality to attain and maintain excellence. The tenure of the nominated members shall be for 2 years. It will meet once in 3 months. The manner of meeting and recording its proceedings have also been incorporated. It is not forthcoming as to how there could be a Governing Council to CIST when it has to function under the direct control of the Syndicate; and how its financial activities could be supervised by the Governing Council when the finance wing of the University is accountable for finances and accounts of

the whole University including its Constituent Institutions. This require a meticulous examination.

3) Clause 6 pertains to appointment of a Director identifying a vacant post of Professor on redeployment. It has not been spelt out which Professors post will be abolished and redesignated as Director. It should specifically indicate the cadre post of Professor redesignated as Professor and Director in CIST. As otherwise the pay scale of Rs. 16400-22400 attached to the post of Professor is not admissible to an ex-cadre post of Director. It is therefor imperative that the post should be designated as Professor and Ex-Officio Director by substituting Sub-clause (1) of clause 6, also sub clause (2) of clause 6.

4) Clause 7 pertains to appointment of teaching faculty on contract with the approval of the Vice Chancellor for a specific training programme besides Guest faculty, Visiting faculty and Honorary faculty. A provision has also been made for payment of honorarium, TA/DA. Unless a sanctioned post exists it is impermissible to appoint on contract. Hence depending upon the requirement of the Professors to function as teaching faculty, specific post of Professor should be identified for redesignating and shifting them to CIST.

5) Clause 8 deals with other staff under the control of the Director. It contemplates creation of following posts;

(1) Assistant Director	1
(2) Office Manager cum Personal Assistant to Director	1
(3) Technical Assistants	2
(4) Administrative Assistant	1
(5) Attenders	2

Pay scale of the above posts have not been indicated. However, it has been specified in clause 8.2 that the qualification, pay, tenure, duties and responsibilities shall be as specified and modified from time to time. Such a provision is ultravires of the KSU Act 1976 for the reason

that creation of posts and determination of emoluments and conditions of service shall be by means of only statute. The powers of which cannot be delegated to Governing Council which does not enjoy a legal status.

7) As regards the funding the initial seed money is Rs. 20 lakhs under clause 9. It is in the form of a soft loan refundable within 5 years to the University fund. The scenario is in the nature of the CIST having not any co-relation with the University funds. The finances of which will be managed by it only without the intervention of the Finance Officer. Such a provision is totally repugnant to Sec. 41,42,43 of the KSU Act, 1976. It should be treated as an integral component of the University and all its activities should be submerged with academic, administrative and financial control but not through a Governing Council. It could amount to redelegation of powers which is legally impermissible.

8) The CIST has been empowered to offer the courses which are Computer based, Skill oriented in IT Industry vide clause 10. There shall be a Managing Committee of experts for every course constituted by the VC. The Committee shall define the title, syllabi, fee-structure etc and manner of imparting the training for the specified number of contact hours as dictated by the changing needs which are flexible. The contact hours of the courses are categorised into 120,240, or 480 and more, designated as Diploma/Advanced Diploma. Training agencies may utilise the existing spare capacity of computer hard-ware and software class rooms, library, materials etc of the University under a MOU. Each course shall have an Evaluation Committee constituted by the VC under the Member Secretaryship of the Director. Provisions have also been made for attendance, internal assessment and conduct of examination and mode of evaluation of the answer scripts and results will be published through grading. Certificate or Diploma will be issued through the participating agencies to the successful candidates in the name of CIST, University of Mysore. These provisions are again contrary to sections 27, 29, 37 and 39 relating to powers of the AC to make Regulations/Ordinance, regulating the courses of study in relation to Diploma or Certificate issuance by the University. The CIST itself cannot be endowed with such delegated authority and power.

8) While the CIST could have a steering committee for day to day co-ordination in administrative and academic matters, all policy decisions will have to be taken by the appropriate academic and executive statutory bodies of the university. It would not be correct to delink the CIST from the Syndicate or the Finance Committee. All permanent teaching and

non-teaching posts shall be filled by redeployment only. There is an attempt in clause 8.3 to bypass the statutory Boards of Appointment which is not acceptable. The V.C should be aware of the fact that persons appointed through Selection Committees invariably go to court and get their services regularised and at that point of time the Government ends up paying salaries. It is better to manage with guest/visiting faculty and not to make appointments.

9) Loan from University to CIST; while the CIST should be self financing, surplus funds from here should cross subsidise those academic programmes that are economically unviable yet indispensable in the view of the university. The funds of CIST are an integral part of Mysore University is overall budgeted outlay. It is not clear why MU wants such a multiplicity of committees to revise the curriculum. This is so bureaucratic. Shorn of the hype, all Mysore University wants to do is replicate the success of the hundreds of institutes that offer short term courses in soft ware application-but, without the huge bureaucratic structure and processes which it contemplates. Existing BOSES can be strengthened instead of creating scores of committees to eat up all profits.

10) In view of the above I am directed to return the Statute governing establishment of Centre for Information Science and Technology in Mysore University for its total revamping and remodeling in a right perception by adopting the curious perspectives revolving it as adverted herein above. Care should be taken that it does not envisage creation of any post and the powers and superintendents of the statutory authorities of the University like BOS, Faculty, AC, BOE, Planning Board, Syndicate and Finance Committee are abridged, squeezed or taken away tantamounting to the ultravires of the provisions of KSU Act, 1976 and the Statutes, the Ordinances and the Regulations enacted thereunder.
